### **HOUSE TROPHY**

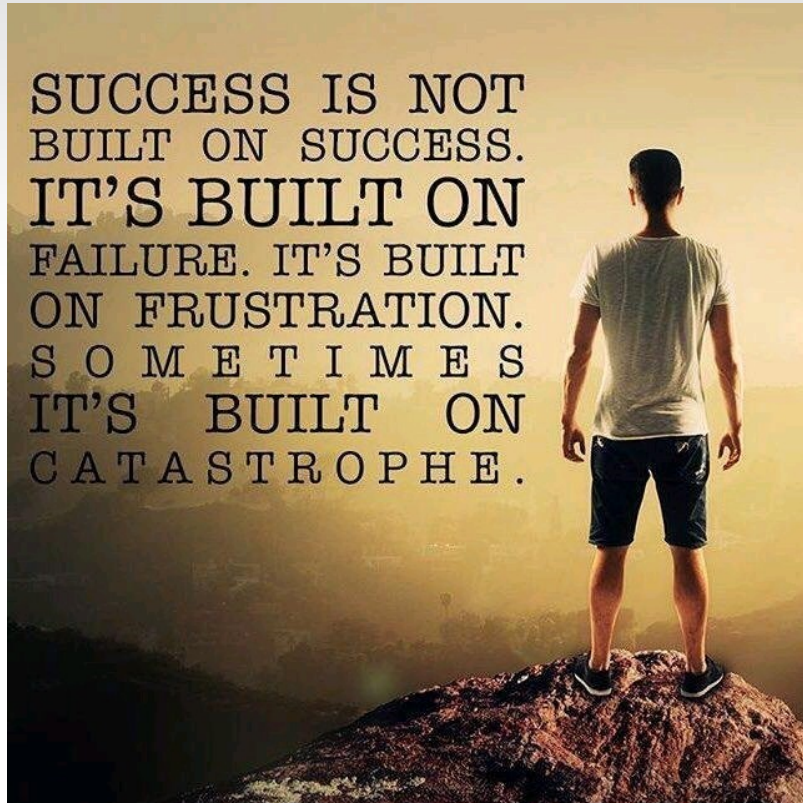
